 It's great to have adventures now and then and it's fantastic to have good friends to share them with. But, when is there time to enjoy friendship and adventure together? Life doesn't make that a very easy thing to do.

Well, let's MAKE time! Announcing the new Teen Adventure Series.

Questions you may want to ask ~

1) What is this Teen Adventure Series?

Teens can come together two or three times each month for fun and adventures — sometimes indoors and sometimes out in nature — to have great times with old and new friends.

2) When is it?

The Teen Adventure Series will begin in June and will continue through the summer months. Some events will be for an evening, others for a day.

3) Who can come to the Teen Adventure Series?

These adventures are for teens interested in fun, adventure and friendship, whether or not they will be attending Living Wisdom High School. However, the number of teens who can participate is limited.

4) To participate, do I have to come to everything, or can I pick and choose?

You can definitely be picky! Take a look at the activities listed and come to those that you wish to. Your choice.

5) Do I need to register first, or can I just come?

You need to register in advance, especially because we will be planning and buying supplies and food (like pizza), based on the number we know will be coming along. Also, space is limited, so let us know.

6) How many kids can participate?

Generally, there will be between 8 and 15 kids, give or take a few. Register early to assure your place.

7) What's the cost?

Different events will cost different amounts, depending on the expenses for that activity. For example, the Art and Pizza activity is only \$15, and that even includes pizza and drink.

I. JUNE: Exploring, hiking and a beach picnic at Half Moon Bay

Date and Time: Saturday, June 17, starting at 9:00 - 4:30

Place: Meet at LWHS at Cubberley

Details: Let's enjoy a sunny day with some easy hiking, visiting an organic farm, tossing Frisbees, swimming and a picnic on the beach. Simple picnic provided, but you can also bring something good to enjoy and share with friends.

Cost: \$20 (includes a picnic of simple vegetarian goodies) Maximum number of kids: 15

II. JUNE & JULY: Art & Pizza — The Singing Tree of Life

Date and Time: Friday, June 23 and Friday, July 7, 5:00 – 9:00

Place: LWHS, Cubberley, Room B5

Details: Groups of teens all over the world are creating something called "The Singing Tree of Life," a 8' x 12' art mural that we create on a LWHS school wall for all to see and enjoy. Everyone participating will have the opportunity to create and contribute as they are inspired to do. Absolutely no art talent is required, but if you happen to have some, bring it along!

Naturally, we'll be sure to take a break for yummy pizza!

Cost: \$15 each evening (includes the pizza and drink)

III. **JULY: Ocean Kayaking in Santa Cruz**

Date and Time: Tuesday, July11th from 9:00 - 6:00

Date and Time: Friday, July 21st from 6:00 – 10:30 pm

Place: LWHS at Cubberley

Details: With the kids help, our classroom will be converted into a comfortable theater lounge, perfect

for an evening of double-feature movies, popcorn, pizza and drinks. Great fun!

Cost: \$15, including pizza dinner Maximum number of kids: 15

V. JULY & AUGUST: Communications Camp and a day at Golden Gate Park with Ramdas (See separate flyer for more information)

Date and Time: July 31 through August 10 (9 days); 9:00 – 4:00

Place: LWHS at Cubberley

Details: Communication Camp is an "academic camp" aimed at prepping middle school and current high school students for the academic rigors of high school. Specifically, the class is aimed at engaging and enabling teens to find their "voice" through strengthening research, analysis, writing, and presentation skills. Students will learn how to effectively express and support their ideas in multimedia communication- skills that will benefit students in most every subject, not just English Language Arts. The last day will be a sun-filled day spent in Golden Gate Park.
